Award Selection Process

Nominations for the award shall be submitted to the Executive Committee by June 20th. The Executive Committee will make a recommendation to the MMA Board of Trustees at their September meeting.

Award Criteria

Nominations should include nominee's current title, organization, contact information, and qualifications for the award. Qualifications include:

1. **Dedication to uniting physicians** to promote collaboration among physicians, to protect the patient-physician relationship, and to advocate for the interests of patients.
2. **Demonstrated commitment** to the physician profession demonstrated through actions taken to promote the profession, advocate for the continued improvement of the profession, and enhance the professional lives of Montana physicians.
3. Current or past **relationship with the MMA**.

Award

The recipient will be presented with the award at either the MMA Annual or Interim Meeting. The recipient will receive a plaque, expenses to attend the annual or interim meeting, and named as MMA Honorary Member.
